
How a top pet supply retailer overturned an accessibility lawsuit without settling



Overview

Centinela Feed is a family-owned chain of retail pet supply stores in Southern California. Acknowledging the importance of internet accessibility, Centinela Feed became an accessiBe customer just over three years ago to provide an inclusive experience for all users. However, challenges emerged following the recent increase in accessibility-related lawsuits. In August 2023, Centinela Feed received a complaint alleging that its website violated the California UNRUH Civil Rights Act, citing accessibility issues.
